To Whom It May Concern:

The American University of Rome gladly accepts the invitation to offer scholarships for students that have taken the Italian Advanced Placement Exams under the following terms:

- Two high school students that have taken the Italian AP exam and received a score of 5
- Must be 18 or over to be able to enroll at AUR
- We require official AP score and High School transcript

We offer within our summer session II in July (see academic calendar on www.aur.edu):

1. Registration as non-matriculated students (transcript with grades and credit will be issued upon the end of the session)
2. Free tuition for one course in Introduction to Italian Culture and Food (ITL212)
3. Free housing for the course period in shared room with other AUR students within AUR fully furnished apartments inventory (this includes accommodation only, no meals)
4. Registration to one additional course on our offering at the reduced tuition fee of \$1,000.

It is highly recommended that students who receive the scholarship take a second course. This would allow for a total of six transferable credits towards a bachelor degree. This will also show academic commitment of the student and engagement towards academic studies.

We thank the Italian Embassy in Washington and EduItalia very much for these intercultural efforts and look forward to receiving further information on the award process and ultimately welcoming the scholarship recipients on campus.
