Subject: Full Tuition and Housing Scholarship for AP Italian Student - Summer 2027

To whom it may concern,

I am writing to offer one summer scholarship to be assigned to a student who shows exceptional merit in the study of Italian language and culture by excelling in their AP Italian Language and Culture Exam with a score of 4 or above.

The ISI Abroad - Umbra Institute Summer 2027 AP Italian Scholarship requires that its recipient be at least 18 years of age and that they hold a cumulative high school GPA of 3.5 or above. An electronic transcript and academic letter of recommendation will be requested at the time of enrollment.


This scholarship is designed to equal a total value of \$5,750 - the cost of enrolling in 1 course through the Umbra Institute's Summer 2 General Studies Program (a 4-week program). The recipient may choose any one 200- or 300-level course available in Summer 2 as listed at www.umbra.org/courses. This award covers the academic program tuition, pre-departure assistance, airport transfers (pick up and return - FCO to Perugia to FCO), a comprehensive orientation program and welcome dinner, housing in shared-bedroom apartments with Wi-Fi, 24-hour emergency assistance throughout the program, CISI Health Insurance for the program dates, a farewell festa and Umbra transcript. A US transcript can be requested for a fee of \$250. A second course can be added for a fee of \$1,000. Limited Institute-sponsored cultural activities are included, others may incur an extra cost and are optional.

Please note that this scholarship does not include any housing upgrade costs, meals, airfare, textbooks, course activity fees, or other expenses not specified above.

Once awarded placement, the student must complete the Institute's comprehensive pre-departure process by all deadlines. We ask that the initial application form be completed by March 15, 2027 and that the student commit to the program by April 1, 2027, at the absolute latest. Early applications are strongly encouraged to help the student navigate all pre-departure requirements in a timely and efficient manner. The student is expected to complete all other predeparture requirements (ex. Virtual orientation) by the deadlines given for each, as a condition of acceptance and enrollment.
